The new English National Curriculum has its roots firmly set in reading, writing and spoken language. Every year group has a set programme of study that covers these strands with key skills set out in all areas.

Reading objectives help children develop competency with word reading and comprehension.

Writing objectives help children to develop their skills with transcription (spelling and handwriting), composition, vocabulary, punctuation and grammar.

The spoken language helps children to explain their understanding of books and other reading, and prepare their ideas before they write.

The key schemes we use in school to teach our children are the Read Write Inc scheme, which we use to deliver our structured, consistent phonics teaching.

We use some of the Read Write Inc texts, alongside Oxford Reading Tree and Project X books to ensure our guided reading sessions are text rich, engaging and appropriate for all levels and age groups.
