In all mathematics teaching and learning at St Wilfrid's we aim to provide a useful way of viewing the world, a tool for logical thinking and a means of communicating with others. We want our pupils' to be confident mathematicians who enjoy the challenge of their mathematical learning and are excited by the possibilities their skills give them in life.

Our mathematics learning is based on the new National Curriculum 2014 and we teach the strands of Number, Measurement and Geometry at Key Stage 1 with Number, Measurement, Geometry, Statistics, Ratio and Proportion and Algebra coming into Key Stage 2.

We use Abacus to support the planning of our lessons in years 1 to 5. All KS2 pupils can also use Mathletics to practice their calculation skills in a fun way.

We aim to develop cross-curricular links with other areas of learning so that pupils are able to apply their mathematical skills in a variety of contexts including 'real-life' situations.

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
