Is it ok to steal the golden eggs? How would you feel if a Giant chased you?</p> <p>Make a thank you card for Santa Write a thank you letter to Santa</p>
<p>Physical Development Can you climb up and down different equipment like Jack? Walk and move like a giant, a cow, a hen or Jack Plant a seed in a plastic cup and watch it grow in the window Practice putting on and fastening your coat</p>	<p>Expressive Arts and Design Playdough - make a beanstalk using dough Lego/bricks/duplo - make a castle for the giant to live in Role play - pretend to be a giant Make a musical instrument using an empty bottle and rice or pasta Songs and rhymes - 5 currant buns, 5 little speckled frog and 5 little men in a flying saucer</p>	<p>Understanding of the World Nature walk - look for signs of Winter Freezing and melting - place bowls and containers of water in your garden and see what happens overnight Measure trees, plants and brushes</p>
