<p><b><u>Geography:</u></b></p> <p>Read the powerpoint about the rivers of the world and then complete the worksheet, you may need to do this in a blank document on the computer.</p> <p>You will need to research some of the rivers on the computer or in an atlas if you have one.</p>	<p>Label the different features of the river. If you are doing in in a blank word document I would suggest numbering them from top to bottom on the left as 1 – 4 and on the right as 5 – 11.</p> <p>You might have to google some of the vocabulary, see how many you can work out even if it isn't all of them.</p>	<p><b><u>PSHE:</u></b></p> <p>What is plastic?</p> <p>Read the powerpoint. Write a list of things that we use plastic for – what things are made from plastic? And why do you think this is?</p> <p>Watch this video about plastic and make some notes.
